The *boerek* is a regal Turkish hors d'oeuvre with a delicious cheese and herb filling wrapped in buttery phyllo dough. For over 35 years, the Bethesda Nursery School community makes and sells boereks as its fall fundraiser. It stands as a unique and storied tradition at Bethesda. Practically speaking, boereking raises about \$5,000 that goes toward improving and enriching the BNS community. Our goal this year is to make and sell 500 boxes of boereks. To accomplish this we need your help. We are asking BNS families to both sell boereks and make boereks.

Attached is an order form to use for selling boereks to family, friends and co-workers. You can let people know (or remind them) that boereks will spruce up any holiday party, are the perfect gift, and paired with carrot sticks make a well rounded dinner for the little ones! Each box contains 24 boereks, and they sell for \$13 per box, or 2 boxes for \$25. Please return your order form by Monday, November 13.

Below is the schedule for making boereks. All work is done in the church kitchen. Children are welcome to play in the Campanius Room during the morning sessions. Evening sessions are for adults only. Feel free to stop in for part of a session- any amount of time you give is appreciated.

And remember, boereking (aka rolling) experience is not required. You can, and will, learn on the job. Sage boereking alumnae will tell you that the fun is in the rolling. Don't miss out.
